Centennial Care

Centennial Care is the new name of the New Mexico Medicaid program. Most people who are currently enrolled in a New Mexico Medicaid program will be eligible for Centennial Care. For all Medicaid programs, you have to meet certain federal guidelines.

Adults ages 19 to 64 qualify if:

A marketplace of private healthcare plans in New Mexico that cover the uninsured, people who can't afford employer plans and those buying their own insurance but who want better options. Also covered are small businesses with 50 employees or fewer.
