We prioritize services that are available to Grant County residents for no or reduced costs, and information on services and programs that are not widely available. This is not a phone book, or even a comprehensive list – it is merely a listing of known resources existing at the time of publication that fit our criteria. Given the variety of categories of services we address, this criteria is applied individually to each section.
